The section consists of articles of various aspects of Volleyball and Beach Volley.

# **COACHES: Volleyball and Beach Volley**

- Technical and tactical
- o Planning methodology and training sessions.
- o Game analysis and scouting.
- Physical conditioning.
- Nutrition and mental abilities (beach volley).

# **REFEREES: Volleyball and Beach Volley**

- o Regulation update and action's guide.
- Refereeing skills.
- Situations analysis and cases.
- o Refereeing psichology and personality.

## NATIONAL FEDERATIONS COMMITMENTS

- Select and submit articles from their own coaches and referees with prestigious and verifiable Curriculum and experience.
  - Coaches (National teams coaches, coaches top-level, high performance, etc.)
  - o Referees: International or Candidates.
- Secuence of presentations : overall 2014.

1st month: Volleyball coach.
2nd month: Volleyball Referee
3rd month: Beach Volley coach
4th month: Beach Volley Referee

The articles must be submitted to the WEVZA Secretariat twenty (20) days before publication.

### **FEATURES OF ARTICLES**

- The articles must be original, and abstracts, summaries or Courses, Seminars and Clinics notes will not be accepted.
- The articles should be written in English.
- Article specifications:
  - o The articles must be submitted in a PDF file, maximum 10 MB
  - The text should be presented in Calibri font 12, single espace, with 2.5 cm margin on both sides.
  - It is possible to attach four to eight photos on related items and in high quality digital format, with a minimum resolution of 200 megapixels and a minimum size of 600 KB and maximum size of 1 MB each picture.
  - The tables should be numbered in the text with numbers in the order they are mentioned in the text. They should have a title to be located above the table.
    Abbreviations should be explained at the bottom of the table. A maximum of 5 tables per article is recommended.
  - Figures should be numbered consecutively in the text, abbreviated and in parentheses. The recommended number of figures is up to 10.
  - In the case of articles containing audiovisual clips, the author must provide the appropriate link to forward to an image management platform (Youtube, etc.). The format of the videos should be: .AVI, .MP2, .MP4 or .WMV
  - The articles must have the following specifications:
    - *Title of the article.*
    - Author/s and date of completion.
    - National Federation.
    - Category (theme).
    - Summary (10 lines maximum).
    - Article 3 to 10 pages maximum.
    - Bibliography.
