Born in Scotland, he is considered to be an enthusiast of modern development at the level of rule-making and refereeing. His achievements include having participated in more than 6 Olympic Games as a referee or referee delegate. He was chairman of the rules and playing commission of the FIVB from 2002-2016. Director of the FIVB refereeing education platform from 2017-2021.

Wojciech Maroszek (POL)

Current Chairman of the Polish Referees' Committee. Started refereeing in 1993 and became a professional referee in the Polish league from 2002. FIVB referee in World League and VNL since 2012. First referee at the semi-finals of the last Olympic Games in Tokyo in 2021. He has also participated in the following Club World Championships (2013, 2017 and 2018), and World Championships (2014, 2018 and 2022).



Avelino Azevedo (POR)

Member of the CEV Refereeing Commission and one of the three members responsible for the beach volleyball Rules Commission. Physical Education Teacher with a Master's Degree in Sport Psychology, has participated as an international REFEREE from 1987 to 2016. Among his extensive track record he has the honour of having refereed the first Olympic beach volleyball match in Atlanta 1996.

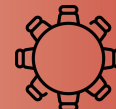
